全美臺灣客家文化基金會(THCFA) 將如往年一樣，參與龍舟賽的攤位以推展客家文化，今年客家文化基金會將提供客家 DIY，如方口獅等等。

The Taiwanese Hakka Culture Foundation of America (THCFA) will have a booth at the Dragon Boat Race to promote Hakka culture. THCFA will offer craft projects for adults and children; Hakka mascot “Fangkou Lion”, 3-D pop-up cards with Hakka greeting and 3-D hanging ornaments.



「客家方口獅」是客家文化的吉祥物，嘴巴大大方四口，象徵吉祥如意好運到！在傳統的客庄，舉凡慶典、祝壽、開幕等場合，都少不了方口獅。對於客家人而言，有著舉足輕重的地位，也是唯一可以進入廟宇的獅子，隨著先民從中國帶入。“大家好”是最普遍的客家人見面問安語而和平吊飾是希望全世界能夠平安康。

The Hakka "Fangkou Lion" is the mascot of Hakka culture. With its large, square-shaped mouth, it is the symbol of fortune and good luck! In traditional "Hakka Zhuang" (i.e., Hakka villages), Fangkou Lions play an important role in many occasions such as celebrations, birthdays, and ceremonies. In Hakka culture, the Fangkou Lion is the only lion that has privilege to enter the ancestral temple. The 3-D pop-up card display Hakka children in the traditional Hakka blue clothing and greet people with "TaiGaHo", the most common word when Hakka people meet. "HePing" is peace in Chinese, the hanging ornament is a symbol for the world peace.
